Councilmember Shields made a motion to approve the May 12, 2021 Community and Economic Development Committee agenda as presented, seconded by Vice Chair DeMoro.

- A. [2021-4107](#) Approval of the April 14, 2021 Community and Economic Development Action Letter.

Vice Chair DeMoro made a motion to approve the April 14, 2021 Community and Economic Development Committee action letter, seconded by Councilmember Shields.

- B. [2021-4150](#) Presentation and Continued Discussion - Recreational Vehicle and Trailer Parking provisions (Unified Development Ordinance and Property Maintenance Code).

Mark Dunning, Assist. City Manager, provided a history of parking regulations based on the City's Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) and the Property Maintenance Codes pertaining to parking on private property. He stated there is enforcement confusion between the UDO and the Property Maintenance Codes regulations due to inconsistencies. Staff's goal is to correlate the UDO and property maintenance code to create a clearer understanding for both citizens and staff by establishing consistent standards to help improve compliance in the community.

After discussion, the Committee directed staff to prepare information, with suggested changes and examples, to bring back to the committee for future discussion and review.
